Dr. Gregg Li Ka-Lok is a Vice Chairman of BPF. He is also the Principal of the Regional Corporate Governance (CG) Practice in Asia for Aon, a premier consultancy in governance and risk management with over 40,000 employees worldwide. The CG Practice covers 22 countries and is mandated to assist clients of Aon improve the impact and design of their governance, proactively managing risks.

Prior to Aon's acquisition in 2006, Dr. Li ran his own governance consultancy under G. Li & Co and was also the Founder of the Academy of Management Consultancy, a social enterprise. In 1982, Dr. Li started his career in Washington, D.C., as an industrial and information engineer and since then has worked in strategy development and execution at Citibank, Coopers & Lybrand MCS, American Express TRS (East Asia North Pacific), the East West Center in Honolulu, and the University of Hong Kong as the head of their management think tank.

Dr. Li's public service continues through his participation as a teacher and mentor throughout Asia. He is a Visiting Professor at Tsinghua University, HKU, and University of Science and Technology on the topic of strategy and corporate governance; a former member of the HKSAR Central Policy Unit, a past Chairman of the International Institute of Management Consulting Institutes for Asia; an Honorary Advisor of CG at the Baptist University, and is the Global Corporate Governance Advisor of Monte Jade, a non-profit venture capitalist body based in San Francisco.

He was educated at Washington University in St. Louis (BA); University of Hawaii (MA); UCLA (MBA), and Warwick University in the UK (Eng. Doc.) He is a Fellow and Certified Management Consultants, a Certified Information Security Analyst, and the Subject Matter Specialist on Corporate Governance for the Hong Kong Council for Academic Accreditation. Dr. Li has written several books and over a dozen articles on corporate governance and management consulting since 1991.
